The Northern Alberta Business Hall of Fame

Established by Junior Achievement of Northern Alberta in 1980, the Northern Alberta Business Hall of Fame celebrates the lifetime accomplishments of Alberta's most distinguished business leaders. Each year, inductees are chosen for their enduring contributions to the economic development and prosperity of Alberta and often Canada as well. Inductees are recognized for their outstanding achievement and merit of the highest degree, especially in service to the Alberta economy or to the Alberta business community.

As leading examples of achievement in business and in life, these individuals have demonstrated the qualities necessary to ensure the success and competitiveness of Alberta and Canada in a global marketplace. The annual Business Hall of Fame Gala Dinner is the most important fundraising event supporting Junior Achievement of Northern Alberta & NWT.

Through a public call for nominations, candidates are submitted to Junior Achievement Northern Alberta & NWT and Grant Thornton and presented for consideration to an independent Selection Committee. The Selection Committee is comprised of individuals from the JA Northern Alberta & NWT Board of Governors. JA Governors are past inductees or "Laureates" of our Business Hall of Fame.

The **"2023 Alberta Business Hall of Fame – Northern Alberta" Celebration** will take place in Fall 2023. The Inductees will be announced in spring 2023.

Nomination Criteria

The Northern Alberta Business Hall of Fame honours the outstanding lifetime contributions Inductees have made to our province's or nation's economic development and growth, providing role models to enterprising young Albertans for generations to come.

As leaders and mentors, the Inductees have earned the respect of their peers for their integrity and sound business ethics. They also have a history of community philanthropy.

- 1. Vision —** The nominee will have demonstrated outstanding vision as a founder or at the helm of one or more business organizations over many years, applying entrepreneurial and management skills and insights to initiatives that have led the organization to measurable new heights of success.
- 2. Leadership —** The nominee will have impacted the Alberta and/or Canadian economy through verifiable financial success, job creation, expansion and innovation. The jobs they have created and the products and services they have developed play a significant role in maintaining our high standard of living. The nominee will have demonstrated leadership throughout their lives, and have a record of leading others to success. They will have demonstrated determination and perseverance.
- 3. Integrity —** The nominee will be widely respected by their peers and will be considered an excellent role model for future generations of entrepreneurs and business leaders. Their integrity and business ethics are unquestionable and have contributed to improving respect for the Albertan and Canadian businesses communities in general.
- 4. Legacy —** The nominee will have utilized their influence and energy to further the Albertan or Canadian social and economic well-being, as demonstrated through leadership in philanthropy or community-based initiatives. They will have been commonly recognized and applauded for their business and philanthropic initiatives and their overall legacy.

The JA Northern Alberta & NWT Alberta Business Hall of Fame recognizes the important contributions made by all members of Alberta's diverse business community.

Nominations that reflect our current leadership character are welcomed and encouraged.

Please note: Nominations may be posthumous. It is expected that a relative will attend the event and accept the award on their behalf.
